*LL.M. in U.S. Law students for whom English is a second language in which they have not reached academic competence may petition for language accommodations during examinations. This applies only to classes taken on a pass/no pass basis. If the petition for accommodations is granted, the language accommodations may include additional time on examinations, up to time-and-a-half, and/or the use of a translating dictionary. Exchange/LL.M. program in U.S. Law students take exams on a graded basis and are therefore not eligible to petition for language accommodations.

Note, on the other hand, that submission of your TOEFL scores does not automatically grant you language accommodations on exams. Language accommodations may be granted to eligible students who submit a timely petition for such accommodations within the first 8 weeks of the semester, and who meet the stated criteria for language accommodations.
